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The cooperation between NORAD and NVE in 1995

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1. GENERAL

The cooperation between NORAD and NVE is formalized through an agreement dated 2 November 1994. This Cooperation Agreement concerns work carried out by NVE directly for NORAD, as well as work for institutions in developing countries. In the first case, each assignment is formalized through a letter from NORAD specifying the services to be rendered. In the latter case the work is specified in an agreement with the concerned institution. The present agreement with NORAD guarantees NVE payment for a minimum of 5 man years.

The work under the Cooperation Agreement is led and coordinated by NVE's Office of International Cooperation (IK). The head of the office is responsible for the coordination of the work under the agreement. IK handles all of NVE's projects related to international activities (unless there is a specific reason for deviation). IK is presently staffed by three professionals within energy/water and one administration officer.

The services of NVE under the agreement covers a wide range of work fields and specialties, and IK draws on the full staff of NVE to carry out the assignments. Thus, during 1995 at total of 34 persons participated on assignments under the agreement. In addition, a total of 10 experts/consultants have been subcontracted to supplement in certain speciality areas.

2. **OVERVIEW OF MAIN ACTIVITIES**

A total of 40 assignments have been worked on during 1995, see Appendix A. Like earlier years, it will be seen that the main categories of work have been to:

- Evaluate plans for hydropower projects
- Prepare Terms of Reference for studies, appraisals etc
- Invite and evaluate proposals
- Assist in negotiations and preparation of contracts
- Conduct preparatory work for institutional cooperation
- Assist in follow-up of ongoing projects
- Conduct appraisals, evaluate and comment on reports
- Host delegation visits, conduct seminars

The largest assignments during the year have been

- Palestinian Water Authority. Institutional cooperation. Preparatory work and project work before institutional agreement takes effect (1429 hours)
- Kihansi Hydropower project. Evaluation of plans. (824 hours)
- Rao Quan Hydropower project. Preparation of Terms of Reference, evaluation of proposals (454 hours)
- Small hydropower, RSA. Report on the feasibility of 5 small hydropower projects in South Africa (411 hours) To be completed in 1996.

Other significant assignments directly for NORAD include:

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- Energy sector cooperation Ethiopia. Preparatory work (318 hours)
- Jhimruk hydropower scheme, Nepal. Completion report (205 hours)
- Pangani hydropower project, Tanzania. Assistance in NORAD's follow-up (169 hours)
- Small hydropower project, Pakistan. Assistance in NORAD's follow-up (192 hours)

Within "Institutional cooperation" agreements in effect during 1995 are:

- Angola, Follow-up on energy policy and preparation of regulations to the General Law on Electricity passed by the Parliament. Short term visits by NVE personnel. (459 hours)
- Angola, Water resources legislation. Very little activity in 1995. The project will be formally terminated in 1996 (92,5 hours)
- Namibia, Electricity legislation. A draft law is ready for final discussions before enactment (92 hours)
- Zambia. Support regarding development of management information and billing system (164 hours)
- Laos, Electricity legislation ready for enactment. Water resources law drafted (208,5 hours)
- Palestinian Territory. Development of Palestinian Water Authority. In cooperation with SFT and NIVA (1429 hours)

Institutional cooperation expected to be formalized through agreements in 1996:

- Nepal, Electricity and water resources legislation. Continuation of earlier work
- Republic of South Africa. Assistance to the National Electricity Regulator in establishing a new regulatory framework in RSA.
- Uganda, Assistance to Ministry of Natural Resources in establishing a new regulatory and legal framework in the electricity sector.
- Ethiopia, Energy, Department in the Ministry of Mines and Energy.
- Ethiopia, Hydrology Studies, Department of the Ministry of Water Resources

3. TIME CONSUMPTION AND COSTS

Time consumption and costs for each activity are shown in Appendix A, Table A-1 to A-4. With one man-year being 1535 hrs of work as defined in the Cooperation Agreement, the total work comes to 5.5 man-years of which 4.75 (86%) are related to NORAD's Consultancy Allocation and 0.75 (14%) is related to direct Institutional Cooperation.

Of the hours related to NORAD's Consultancy Allocation, 50% is related to requests from NORAD's Energy and Maritime Division, 29% to the Industrial and Commercial Department and 20% to Health Division (mainly preparatory work for the Palestinian Agreement).

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5. COMMENTS ON ACHIEVEMENTS, PROBLEMS ETC

The completion of individual tasks and assignments to everybody's satisfaction creates considerable burden on the most experienced personnel of NVE. Personnel on middle and high management level are involved, particularly in our programmes on institution building and development of new legislation. While it is felt that the defined targets and objectives in general have been fulfilled up to now, new and increased activities foreseen in 1996 and coming years necessitate a dedicated effort to develop a broader personnel base for our activities in developing countries. In addition to allowing relatively inexperienced personnel to participate as trainees (including participation on travels), it will be necessary to provide specific training in the various professional fields (regular courses, seminars etc) for adaptation to conditions in developing countries.

Participation at NORAD's "Bistandsskole" is welcomed as a more general type training of such personnel. NVE has established an in-house training programme in English, from which we now see tangible results.

6. PLAN AND BUDGET FOR 1996

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The planning of activities in 1996 was discussed with NORAD in a meeting 24 January 1996. The agreed activities and budgetted use of personnel is shown in Appendix B. It shows a total input of 6.9 man-years from NVE, i.e. 1.9 man years more than the 5 man years NVE is committed to make available according to the Cooperation Agreement.

A very marked new development is that the part related to direct Institutional Cooperation has increased from 14% in 1995 to an estimated 54% in 1996.
